⁶ “He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: ⁷ ‘the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.’”

**Why does it matter?
How does the Easter story change everything?**

If the Easter story is true, then...

- 1. Everything he said about Himself is true!**
- 2. Everything He said about God is true!**
- 3. Everything He said about His own life, death, and future is true!**
- 4. Everything He said about my life and your life, death, and future is true!**

What is God’s name?

Elohim: (plural) Mighty One.

Adonai: Lord or Master.

EI Shaddai: God Almighty—Protector, Provider.

The Tetragrammaton: (Greek for 4 Letters):

Yod, Heh, Waw, Heh - YHWH

Exodus 3:5-8a,13-14

⁵ “Do not come any closer,” God said. “Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground.” ⁶ Then he said, “I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob.” At this, Moses hid his face, because he was afraid to look at God. ⁷ The Lord said, “I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. ⁸ So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey...”

¹³ Moses said to God, “Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they ask me, ‘What is his name?’ Then what shall I tell them?” ¹⁴ God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: ‘I am has sent me to you.’”

I am who I am = "ehyeh asher ehyeh."

- 1. Self-existing: The only being who does not depend on anything outside of himself for His existence.**
- 2. Unchanging: Immutable; does not fluctuate.**

Yod: Right hand, symbolizing God is at work.

Heh: Ancient symbol for outstretched hands.

Waw: Binding and Securing.

Heh: When doubled up it moves past man's beholding and revelation into Divine beholding and revelation.

Yod: Hand

Heh: Behold

Waw: Nail

Heh: Behold

Behold the hand. Behold the nail.

God's own name bears witness to the work He does.

Romans 1:16-17

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.

¹⁷ For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.”

Believe = pistis: Belief that leads to action.

What are you going to do about it?

R.S.V.P.

R: Repent and acknowledge that you have not been living for Christ. (Brief explanation)

S: Say you're sorry for putting your trust in anything other than God.

V: Verbalize your trust in Jesus's work on the cross to save you.

P: Plunge your past by participating in baptism. Die to your old life and be raised to new life in Christ.

Romans 6:3-4

³ Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

⁴ We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
