## **FORGIVENESS RECEIVED/FORGIVENESS GIVEN**

**Most of life is transactional.**

**Forgiveness is not earned, it is given.**

**The forgiveness we freely receive from God,  
we are then called to freely extend to others.**

Matthew 6:12

<sup>12</sup> Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.”

**Jesus connects receiving forgiveness with extending forgiveness.**

Matthew 6:14-15

<sup>14</sup> “For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. <sup>15</sup> But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.”

**We have been forgiven for far more than we realize.**

Romans 3:23

<sup>23</sup> For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Colossians 3:13

<sup>13</sup> Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

**Forgiveness changes our relationship to the past.

**Forgiveness is choosing not to demand repayment.**

<sup>59</sup> While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, “Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.”

<sup>60</sup> Then he fell on his knees and cried out, “Lord do not hold this sin against them.” When he had said this, he fell asleep.

**Why should we forgive?**

**Because Christ forgave us.**

**Because unforgiveness keeps us chained to the pain.**

**Forgiveness always resembles the cross,  
because forgiveness always costs somebody something.**

#### **HOW DO WE BEGIN?**

- 1. Bring the pain to God.**
- 2. Be honest about the wound.**
- 3. Release the right to revenge.** Romans 12:19 - Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge, I will repay," says the Lord.
- 4. Pray for the person.**
- 5. Repeat the process when necessary.**

**To have that kind of forgiving spirit is Christlike.**
