TRUSTING THE UNCERTAIN OR THE UNSHAKABLE?

Are we fed up with falling backwards, trusting the uncertainty around us to catch us?

Psalm 125:1

¹ Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be shaken but endures forever.

**The comparison of God and the mountains reminds us that
God can be trusted because He has stood the test of time.**

Psalm 125:2

² As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds his people both now and forevermore.

**Fully putting our trust in God allows His protection to surround us.
While His protection is not always from difficulty, it is protection through difficulty.**

Psalm 125:3
